In science class, 1st Grade has been studying bees and even had a taste of honey.

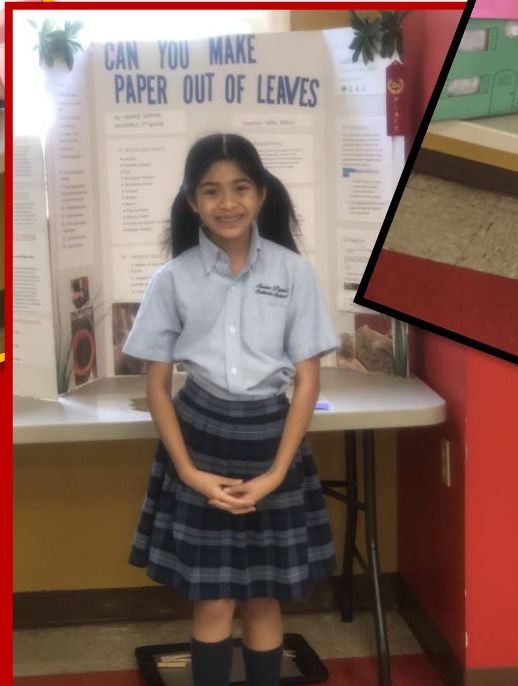
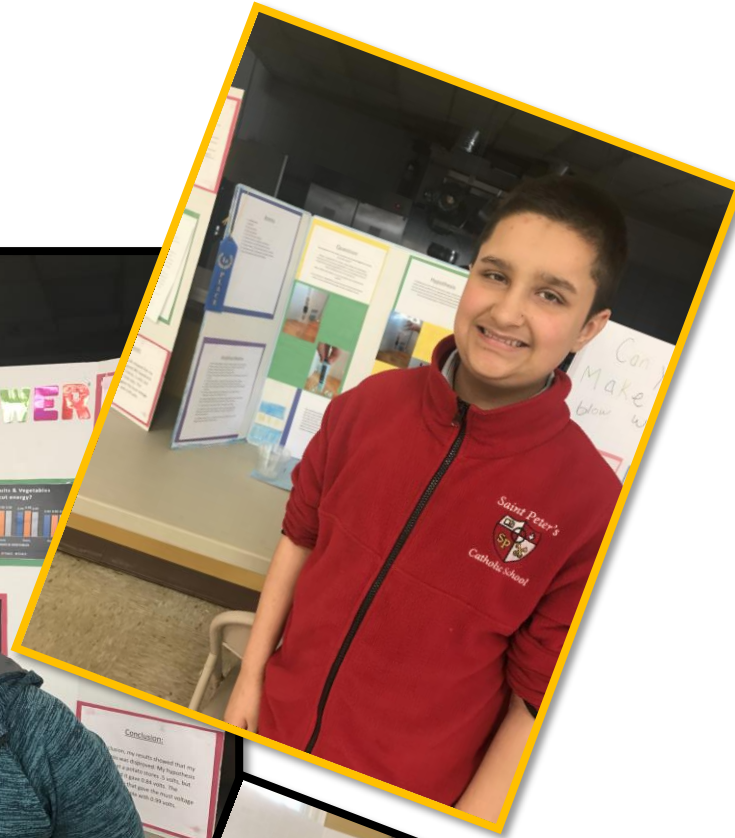
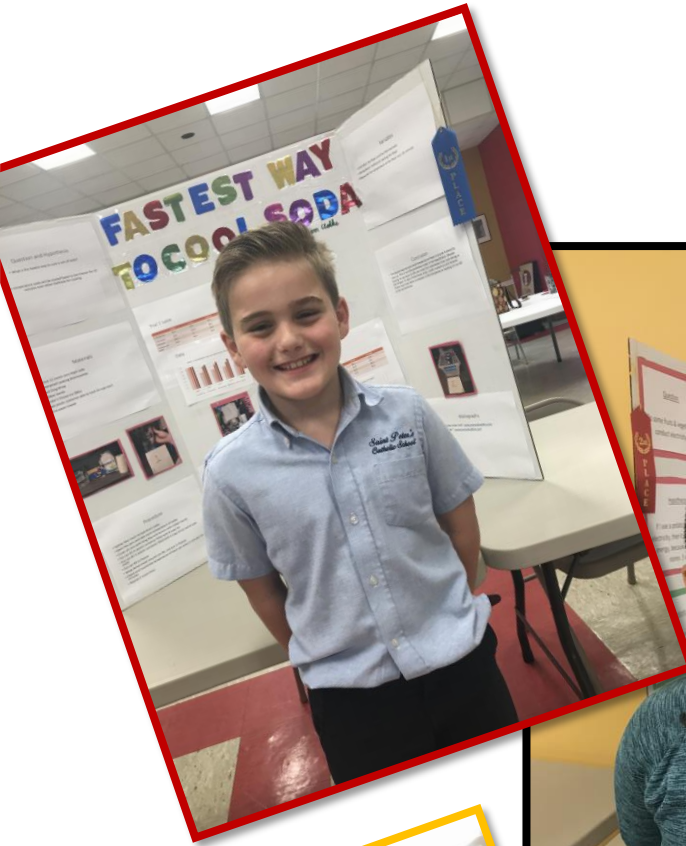
