DRESSED FOR SUCCESS

The dress code at Saint Peter's Catholic School requires that students wear the prescribed school uniform every day. We believe students should always take pride in their appearance. Uniforms also serve the practical purpose of safety since students are easily identifiable and persons not in uniform are easy to spot on our campus. Parents may find that wearing a uniform can get children out of the door more easily in the mornings!

Throughout the year, classroom teachers and administration will be monitoring uniforms. Administration will contact the parents or guardians in the event of any uniform violations.

WHERE TO BUY- Due to delays in shipping, please place your orders as soon as possible.

DAILY UNIFORM: Our provider for the daily uniform is Flynn O'Hara Uniforms. Uniform pieces can be purchased from Flynn O'Hara (www.flynnohara.com). They carry every piece necessary for both boys and girls. Uniform pieces should be clean, in excellent condition, and replaced as wear occurs.

To order, go to www.flynnohara.com and create an account. Parents will need to enter our state (SC) and our school (St. Peter Catholic School - Beaufort, SC) or enter our school code (SC003).

PE UNIFORM: Where to buy: to be updated with new vendor as soon as possible. Please know that the only required items from the school store is the PE uniform. The spirit wear, accessories, backpacks, etc. are NOT required to purchase.

JACKETS, SWEATERS, AND SWEATSHIRTS: In cooler or cold weather, students must wear navy blue cardigans, vests, Saint Peter's sweatshirts with logo, or the red fleece jacket with Saint Peter's Catholic School embroidered on it. Saint Peter's sweatshirts or hoodies may not be worn on Mass days.

No other pullovers, sweatshirts, jackets, or coats may be worn, except for raincoats, when it is raining.

RAINY DAYS: On rainy days, students may wear rain boots while outside. Please send in/pack their school shoes for your student to change into while they are inside.

Please label all clothing items with your child's name for easy return

DRESS UP/DRESS DOWN DAYS

Certain days of the year are designated for dress up or dress down days. On these days, students may wear street clothes, but they are reminded that neat, modest attire is expected. For further details, please refer to the Dress Code in the Parent-Student Handbook. **All students must wear gym shoes if the dress-down day is PE day.** Dress down day rules will accompany these announcements. All uniform regulations and guidelines are subject to the discretion of the principal.

K3 Uniforms	
Shirts	Polo shirt – must be solid color: red, blue, white
Shorts/Pants	Boys – Navy or Khaki pants or shorts Girls – Navy or Khaki pants, shorts, skirts <i>(If your daughter has a jumper, she may wear that as well)</i>
Shoes	Tennis shoes – Velcro is preferred
P.E. Uniform	Solid Red Shirt or Spirit Wear shirt. Tennis shoes with Velcro. Black Athletic shorts from online store or pants.
Hair	No unusual or fad haircuts that draw attention. Hair must be off the collar and above the ears. No shaggy cuts. Hair must be neat with bangs above the eyebrows. Only naturally colored hair is allowed. Items such as hair ribbons and barrettes must be simple. Colors are limited to uniform colors (navy blue, white, red, or uniform plaid). Holiday bows/pins will be on designated days only.
Add-Ons	Students may wear navy blue cardigans, vests, Saint Peter's sweatshirts with logo, or the red fleece jacket with Saint Peter's Catholic School embroidered on it. HOODIES/SWEATSHIRTS MAY NOT BE WORN DURING MASS.

- **Jewelry:** Girls with pierced ears may wear ONE stud in each ear; no dangle earrings. No rings. Subtle religious necklaces may be worn under the student's shirt, (i.e., crosses or miraculous medal). One subtle religious bracelet may be worn on the wrist. No Smart Watches.
- **Nails and Makeup:** No fake nails or nail polish. No makeup.
- **Clothing:** No ripped, torn, or tattered clothing

GIRLS PRE-K4 - 6TH GRADE UNIFORM POLICY

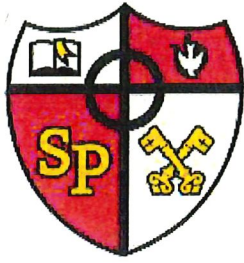
Jumpers	Grades Pre-K4-3 wear blue plaid pleated jumpers. Solid or navy shorts required underneath.
Skirts	Grades 4-6 wear school plaid pleated skirts. Girls must wear solid or navy shorts under skirts.
Blouses/Shirts	Pre-K4-3 Red Flynn O'Hara Polo shirt. (Crest isn't necessary, as it's covered by jumper). Grades 4-6 Red Flynn O'Hara Polo Shirt, MUST be embroidered. All shirts must be tucked into uniform bottoms.
Sweaters/Jackets	Only Navy-Blue sweater, vest, or red fleece jacket with the embroidered school logo.
Socks/Tights	Navy knee socks, solid navy tights or solid navy leggings. Leggings may be worn underneath uniform bottoms; they must match sock color and be tucked into socks.
Shoes	Students may wear tennis shoes/sneakers to SPCS at all times, including to Mass on Thursdays. Should a child or family prefer to have a "church shoe" -black, brown, or navy blue (i.e., Saddle shoes, Loafers, Mary Jane) are appropriate. Sneakers are to have a single, primary/majority color of navy blue, white, gray, or black. Secondary colors on sneakers must be a solid color. No roller-skate shoes, fad shoes. K4-1st Velcro preferred.
Hair	No unusual or fad haircuts that draw attention. Hair must be neat. Bangs must be above the eyebrows. Natural hair color only. Items such as hair ribbons and barrettes must be simple. Colors are limited to the uniform colors (navy blue, white, red, or uniform plaid). Holiday bows/pins will be on designated days only.
P.E. Uniform	Grades Pre-K4-6: wear tennis shoes with laces or Velcro. Spirit Wear shirt from online store. Black Athletic shorts from online store or pants.
Mass Days: Full Dress Uniform	Grades Pre-K4 – 3 must wear school jumper & Light Blue Peter Pan Blouse, long or short sleeve. (Crest isn't necessary, as it's covered by jumper). Grades 4-6: must wear Light Blue Oxford Cloth Shirt, long or short sleeve. MUST be embroidered. Shirts must be tucked in at all times.
Add-Ons	Students may wear navy blue cardigans, vests, Saint Peter's sweatshirts with logo, or the red fleece jacket with Saint Peter's Catholic School embroidered on it. HOODIES/SWEATSHIRTS MAY NOT BE WORN DURING MASS.

- **Jewelry:** Girls with pierced ears may wear ONE stud in each ear; no dangle earrings. No rings. Subtle religious necklaces may be worn under the student's shirt, (i.e., crosses or miraculous medal). One subtle religious bracelet may be worn on the wrist. No Smart Watches.

BOYS PRE-K4 - 6TH GRADE UNIFORM POLICY

Shorts/Pants	Navy Blue Dress Pants or Shorts. (No Cargo or Pleated Pants)
Belts	Brown or Black Leather Belt (Grades 3-6)
Shirts	All shirts must have SPCS logo. Red Flynn O'Hara Polo shirt, MUST be embroidered. All shirts must be tucked into slacks or shorts.
Sweaters/Jackets	Only Navy-Blue sweater, vest, or red fleece jacket with the embroidered school logo.
Socks	Navy Blue
Shoes	Students may wear tennis shoes/sneakers to SPCS at all times, including to Mass on Thursdays. Should a child or family prefer to have a "church shoe" -black, brown, or navy blue, (i.e., Dockers, Loafers) are appropriate. Sneakers are to have a single, primary/majority color of navy blue, white, gray, or black. Secondary colors on sneakers must be a solid color. No roller-skate shoes, fad shoes. K4-1st Velcro preferred.
Hair	No unusual or fad haircuts that draw attention. Hair must be off the collar and above the ears. No shaggy cuts. Hair must be neat with bangs above the eyebrows. Only naturally colored hair is allowed.
P.E. Uniform	Grades Pre-K4-6: wear tennis shoes with laces or Velcro. Spirit Wear shirt from online store. Black Athletic shorts from online store or pants.
Mass Days: Full Dress Uniform	Grades Pre-K4-6: Light Blue Oxford Cloth Shirt, long or short sleeve. MUST be embroidered. All shirts must be tucked in at all times.
Tie	Red, Navy and Silver regimental striped uniform tie.
Add-Ons	Students may wear navy blue cardigans, vests, Saint Peter's sweatshirts with logo, or the red fleece jacket with Saint Peter's Catholic School embroidered on it. HOODIES/SWEATSHIRTS MAY NOT BE WORN DURING MASS.

- **Jewelry:** No earrings or rings No rings. Subtle religious necklaces may be worn under the student's shirt, (i.e., crosses or miraculous medal). One subtle religious bracelet may be worn on the wrist. No Smart Watches.
- **Clothing:** No ripped, faded, torn, or tattered clothing.
- **Nails:** No nail polish
